Days of the week

- Days of the week are not capitalized in Spanish. (Unless it's the first word of a sentence like English).

Vocabulario:

- el día = day
- la semana = week
- ¿Qué día es hoy? What day is today?
- Hoy es = Today is
- ¿Qué día es mañana? What day is tomorrow?
- Mañana es = Tomorrow is
- Ayer fue = Yesterday was **

lunes - Monday	sábado(s) – Saturday(s)
martes - Tuesday	domingo(s) – Sunday(s)
miércoles - Wednesday	
jueves - Thursday	
viernes - Friday	

Definite Articles/ Saying “the”:

- El/ los (la/las) = the (“El” is singular meaning only ____) (“Los” is plural meaning more than 1)
- El/los come before the days of the week for 2 reasons:

1.) To signal the amount of days:

El lunes = Monday
Los lunes = Mondays

2.) To say “on”.... Monday, Tuesday....:

El lunes = on Monday
Los lunes = on Mondays
