Grade Breakdown- Student's grade is NOT based on total points. Final grades are calculated by using the following categories that are weighted (15+25+30+20+10= 100%). Students will be grading other student's work occasionally.

Diario & In class activities- 15% - daily activities (turned in periodically). Journaling entries (checked for completion/date/correctness/ in order.)

Participation- 25% - any in class activities or physically participating (giving an answer)

- A.) **5 points per week** – attentiveness & enthusiasm in class/ actually doing activities w/out reminder to be on task 1 warning will be given. If students are not doing activity (-1), or sleeping (-.5), working on other hw (-.5), on phone (-.5) – you cannot earn negative points.
- B.) **8 points per 10 days**– you must participate 8 times in 10 days provided there are opportunities.
- C.) **Other points (amount will vary) will be awarded for completing in class activities (ie. participating during speaking activities/ actually doing work.)**

Tests (1 per chapter): 30% or substituted by a project

Quizzes: 20%

- Pop quizzes
- Assigned homework (will be graded as a quiz)

Projects (1-3 per semester): 10%

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Tardies/absences:

- Students will be marked tardy 1 minute after the bell has rung (7:16 AM)
- Students will be issued a detention after every 4 tardies.
- A loss of credit could occur at 11 absences.

Backpacks:

- Per our school rules, there are NO backpacks allowed in class.
- Backpacks must be put in lockers BEFORE class
- Tardies will be issued if students must return to their lockers before class.



Hats-Hoods / dress code:

Per our code of conduct...

- shorts/skirts must be finger tip length
- shirts/dresses/skirts must cover shoulders/belly.
- No hats or hoods are to be worn in the classroom.
- Students could receive detention if their dress code is not deemed school appropriate.

Cell phone/electronics policy:

- Phones are to be put away for the ENTIRE HOUR!
- Students who are on their phone during the hour will lose their engagement participation point for the day.
- Warnings will NOT be given.

Doing other homework during Spanish class:

- Other homework needs to be put away during Spanish class.
- Students WILL NOT be given warnings. This will NOT be tolerated.
- Student's work will be collected and put into their corresponding teacher's mailbox.
- Students who are doing other homework will lose their engagement participation point for the hour.

Absent work:

- 1 day absent = 1 day to make up work
- If you are absent and something was collected. Upon returning it is due.
- If you are absent the DAY BEFORE a test/quiz you WILL be taking it.
- **LATE WORK 3 DAYS PAST AN ABSENCE OF 1 DAY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. LATE WORK- 15 % EACH DAY IT IS LATE.**

Visitors/ Hallway etiquette:

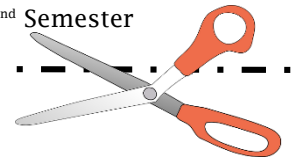
- There are to be NO VISITORS during class. We're busy!
