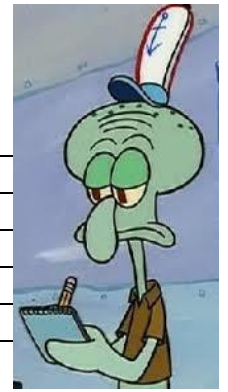

Subject Pronouns:

- MEMORIZE (meanings, formulas, spelling, locations)

Singular	Plural (y = and)
Yo = I	Nosotros = we (masculine) Nosotras = we (feminine) Name y yo
Tú = you (informal)	Vosotros = you all (inf./m) Vosotras = you all (inf./f) Name y tú
Él = he boy's name Ella = she girl's name Usted (ud.) = you (formal)	Ellos = they (masculine) Ellas = they (feminine) Ustedes (uds.) = you all (for.) Name y Name Sr./sra, last name y used

Yo is I
& tú is you (inf.)
Él and ella he and she
Usted is you more formally
Nosotros Nosotras both mean we
Ustedes is y'all the southern way

Grammar (2) – You are able to answer the question in a complete and correct sentence. You must have a subject & a verb.

Fluency (1) – You are prepared to answer the question relatively quickly without dramatic pauses.
