Adjectives change spelling in Spanish!

- Adjectives that end with -o have 4 ways to spell them. (alto, alta, altos, altas)
- Adjectives that end with -e have 2 ways to spell them (paciente, pacientes)
- If you are describing a feminine noun, o → a, e = e
- If you are describing a plural noun, add s (ends with vowel) add es (ends with a consonant)

We use the verb "ser" (to be) to describe how people, places, and things look/act/are.

1 noun (singular)	2 or more nouns (plural)
